Compost Activity Sheet




Compost forms naturally nearly everywhere! The leaves that drop from the trees or grass clippings left on the lawn, plants and animals that die. Over time, these break down or decompose. The rich, dark-brown, crumbly, soil-like material that results is called compost.

Compost can be used to improve the quality of the soil in your garden. This means increaing the nutrients so that plants, vegetables, fruit and flowers will all grow really well.

So what do you need to make compost? If it can rot and is from a plant or animal origin it can compost, but

You need a mixture of what we call "greens" and "browns". Greens are materials that have a high water content like fruit scraps and grass clippings. Browns are materials that have a low water content like twigs
