

Worm's World

Learning Outcome: Pupils will be able to identify different types of worms and describe key facts about worms.

Activity Length: 15 minutes

Curriculum link:

KS1 Year 1 or 2

- Science: working scientifically, investigating, exploring what is in the garden that's useful
- Reading: comprehension
- English: listening and speaking

Resources

• A Worm's World resource sheet

Teaching Activities

- 1. Pupils look through the resource sheet and identify what the information is telling them. Discuss together to ensure understanding.
- 2. Pupils choose their favourite 3 facts that they learned from the resource sheet. Using sentence starters for support, if needed, pupils share their top 3 facts.
- 3. Pupils then create questions to ask each other to ensure understanding of the resource sheet. For example How many different types of worms are there? How are seeds dispersed? What is worm's poo good for? Link this to pupils sharing this information with other members of the class or with a paired class who haven't read this.
